## 2025 TEAM POLICY

### Placements

Students must be **currently** competing at an elite level to be considered for the program- this includes participation and representation in state and national competitions.

While students may indicate their participation in a given sport in their application, the requested placement is not guaranteed.

The delivery of the course is dependent upon student numbers.

### Dress Standards

Students will have a TEAM badge which is expected to be worn as a part of regular College uniform.

Should students receive Colours awards as a part of their achievements, these are expected to be worn with pride.

### Withdrawal from the TEAM Program

The following circumstances may result in a student being removed from the TEAM Program:

- Failure to provide evidence of competition and event attendance
- Misconduct at the College, for example: poor behaviour (inclusive of other classes), or poor attitude towards their studies.
- Overall attendance at the College falls below 65%

If withdrawn, students will be expected to enrol in another Course to replace the TEAM Program.

## 2025 TEAM - STUDENT CONTRACT

### Responsibility of the Student

- Remain at level or above in their sporting activities
- Notify their TEAM teacher of any changes to their engagement in their sporting activities
- Engage in class activities and tasks in a positive manner and be willing to work as a team and learn.

### Absences from the College

- The student must advise of any absences related to competitions ahead of time
- Excessive training or needing time to study are not valid reasons for missing College, and students in this position are encouraged to look at alternatives to face-to-face schooling (eg SIDE)
- Unexplained absences will be treated as truanting.

### Permission to publicise achievements

- From time to time, the College will publicise student external achievements in competitions and events. This includes use of student name and images in Information Updates, and social media posts.
- The College may request students to publicly represent the College at out of hours events, such as awards evenings.
