- Be a role model of student behaviour, dress and approach to education, including behaviour and punctuality
- Act as a responsible delegate and representative to the entire college
- Liaise with your Year group in order that you can represent their wishes and feelings about issues and events
- Administer assemblies and speak well in public
- Represent the College at outside functions, including evenings and weekends
- Keep some information confidential
- Support other councillors and the Council's decisions
- To monitor the Student Forum for concerns, ideas
- Attend regular meetings at lunch a few times per term and possibly after school
